Barton-On-Sea Golf Club, founded in 1897, is situated on the coast, south of the New Forest. Renowned golf course architects Vardon & Colt have influenced a links style layout that provides variety and challenges. Add sea breezes and breath-taking views and the result ensures a memorable experience for golfers of all abilities.

The elegant and newly renovated Clubhouse is truly spectacular, commanding superb views across the Solent to the Needles on the Isle of Wight, along to Old Harry Rocks at Swanage. Situated overlooking the lake and an island green, the Clubhouse offers us a stunning location to host the day's golf and an evening of entertainment.

We invite you to compete in our Golf Day, with teams of four players. This will be a Stableford competition off a maximum handicap of 24 for men and 32 for ladies, with the best two scores on each hole being counted.

There will be a selection of prizes, including for the top teams, best individual scores, nearest the pins and a chance to win an amazing prize for a hole-in-one on the infamous 9th Needles.

Together with this you will be able to compete to win the chance to become Champions of the 2025 Oakhaven Golf Day, with your team's/ company's/ group's name engraved onto The Oakhaven Bowl.

About Oakhaven Hospice

It was the vision of our founders, Phoebe Coates and Dr Jan Swallow that led to an independent hospice for our New Forest communities over 30 years ago. Oakhaven started with just 5 beds, a day hospice and a small team of nurses, doctors and just 7 other members of staff. Soon after our clinical nurse specialists started visiting patients at home.

Oakhaven Hospice has grown to meet demand. Today, our compassionate teams provide **specialist care** and individualised support in ten inpatient beds, in the day hospice, and in patients' homes. Our team of nurses, doctors, counsellors and therapists ease the physical symptoms and offer psychological, spiritual and social support. Currently, at any one time we are caring for over 450 patients and their families, throughout our New Forest, Totton and Waterside communities - **free of charge**.

In addition to patient referrals, Oakhaven Wellbeing provides support and signposting to **everyone in the New Forest, Totton and Waterside** who is navigating a life-limiting illness, caring for a loved one, or experiencing a loss or bereavement.

Last year our running costs amounted to **over £8 million**, with **just 11%** covered by the NHS. For the remainder, we rely on the generosity of our community, through donations, gifts in wills, fundraising and income from our shops and social enterprise care agency, Oakhaven Care Ltd (100% of whose profits help to fund the Hospice).
