Mudford to Barton on Sea

- From the checkpoint, walk the perimeter of Mudford Quay, following the pathway. You will pass the RNLI, The Haven House Hotel, lobster nets (depending on the time of day), until you see a playpark on your left. Continue walking along the coast path passing The Noisy Lobster, the Mudford beach huts and the Beach Hut Cafe.
- There is a section at the end of the Steamer Point beach huts where you will be walking on the sandy/shingle beach - do not take the path up towards Highcliffe Castle. You will eventually meet a gravel path. Continue along this path until the promenade comes to an end (The Cliffhanger Cafe will be above you).
- Do not keep walking along the beach; instead, turn left onto the grass slope. There will be a sign showing you which way to turn. Walk a short distance, where you will see another arrow taking you up a small set of stairs. You will then see our marshal, who will direct you through the back of Hoburne Naish Holiday Park. There will be another marshal on the other side who will let you out of the gate at Barton on Sea.
- **Dogs must be on leads when you walk through Hoburne and please respect the residents and holiday makers while you pass through. Please note: public do not normally have access to the park.**
- Stick to the cliff top - until you go past the Beachcomber Cafe. We will be on the green next to The Beachcomber Cafe.

Please be aware that along the cliff tops at Highcliffe and Barton-on-Sea, you should take great care and not go too close to the cliff edge. We strongly recommend that dogs are kept on a lead along these sections.
